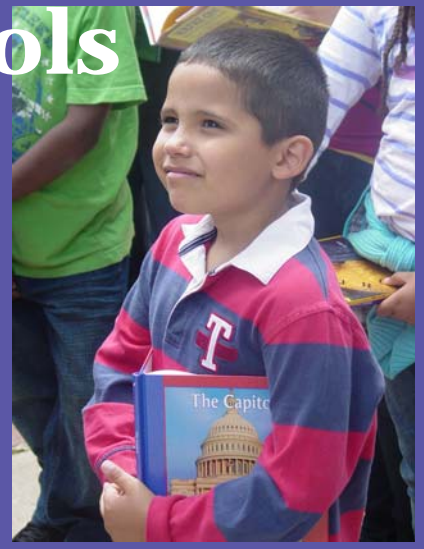

### Delayed Openings and Closings

Occasionally, schools must open late or close early due to weather or other emergencies. When this happens, information and updates are available at [703-866-5300](http://703-866-5300), at [www.acps.k12.va.us](http://www.acps.k12.va.us), on ACPS-TV channel 71 and through email messages sent to E-News subscribers (sign up via the ACPS website).

**Open one hour late** – Students report to school one hour later than the regular opening time and leave at the regular time.

**Open two hours late** – Students report to school two hours later than the regular opening time and leave at the regular time.

**Close one hour early** – Students will be dismissed one hour earlier than the regular closing time. No make-up classes are required.

**Close two hours early** – Students will be dismissed two hours earlier than the regular closing time. No make-up classes are required.

When schools close early or for the entire day, all after-school activities and athletic events are canceled for the day.
