Lyles-Crouch Traditional Academy School Uniform Policy

Dress Uniform: Non-P.E. Days

Girls:

- Navy Blue Slacks, Skirt, Jumper, Shorts or Skort
- White Collar Long or Short Sleeve Shirt
- Dark Brown, Navy or Black Dress Shoes(leather, patent leather, or suede)
- Plain Navy or White socks or tights
- Solid White or Navy Sweater(optional)

Boys:

- Navy Blue Slacks or Walking Shorts
- White Collar Long or Short Sleeve Shirt
- Dark Brown, Navy or Black Dress Shoes(leather, patent leather, or suede)
- Plain Navy or White socks
- Solid White or Navy Sweater(optional)

P.E. Uniform: Worn only on designated P.E. days

Girls: Navy Blue Sweat Pants, Skort or Shorts, Plain White or Navy T-Shirt, Sweat Shirt or LCTA Logo T-Shirt, and Navy, Black or Plain White Sneakers

Boys: Navy Blue Sweat Pants or Shorts, Plain White, Navy T-Shirt, Sweat Shirt or LCTA Logo T-Shirt, and Navy, Black or Plain White Sneakers

Uniform Dress & Appearance: Please adhere to the policy.

- *No capris, culottes, blue jean or denim material.
- *No lights in or skates on shoes and sneakers.
- *No deck shoes, clogs, crocs, boots, open-toed shoes or shoes with heel of foot exposed.
- *Shoes with heels must be no higher than 1 inch.
- *The majority of sneaker color must be navy, black or white.
- *Rain and snow boots may be worn to school, but must be changed to the uniform shoes in the classroom.
- *No sweater, sweatshirts or jackets with hoods. No ponchos
- *No hats and scarves should be worn inside the building while school is in session.
- *No multi-colored and designed stockings or tights.
- *Shorts, skort, and skirt length must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- *Pants and shorts must be worn at the waist line.
- *The length of slacks should be at or below the ankle.
- *No dresses or skirts are to be worn on P.E. days.
- *Belts must be worn with any piece of uniform that has belt loops.(solid black, navy blue or brown) No scarves as belts.
- *Shirts should be long enough to fit and remain tucked inside of skirt, shorts, skort, and slacks.
- *Shirts must be tucked at all times upon entering and while inside of the school building.
- *Undershirts should not be worn as outerwear.
- *Clothing must be clean, without tears, holes, and missing buttons.

Uniform items may be purchased at many local clothing/department stores.
