

Saturday School

ACPS offers Saturday School, a free program which gives students in grades K-12 increased academic support. Parent may bring students to Saturday School for homework assistance. Participation in Saturday School is provided as a resource to students and parents to:

- Increase academic achievement
- Provide homework assistance
- Improve attendance
- Provide SOL support

Administrators may also refer students to Saturday School for minor disciplinary reasons such as tardiness, truancy, coming to class without the necessary materials, and failing to participate in instructional activities. Referral to Saturday School is an additional resource for parents to help keep students on the right track and overcome obstacles to increased academic achievement.

All Saturday School participants must bring the materials they need to complete homework and other assignments. Students must be able to tell the assistant coordinators and tutors what assignments they will work on while at the Saturday School program. Staff and volunteers will be available to assist with most school assignments.

Participants must provide their own transportation and parents must bring valid identification.
