TOPIC: School Health Advisory Board Scope of Work

DESCRIPTION: The School Health Advisory Board recommends the following items to be considered for committee scope of work for the 2013-2014 School Year:

- Continue to monitor implementation of school-based health care planning and implementation, including the existing Teen Wellness Center at T.C. Williams High School and the creation of the mobile health unit to serve William Ramsay, John Adams and Patrick Henry Elementary Schools.
- Monitor problem of substance abuse and prevention efforts and make recommendations for responding to relevant or concerning trends.
- Monitor the implementation of oral health screenings and interventions to meet the oral health needs of ACPS students.
- Continue to work with implementing outreach to uninsured families and increase participation in FAMIS and FAMIS Plus public insurance options.
- Review and monitor new Family Life Education curriculum content and implementation.
- Review Wellness Policy for considered updates and revisions.
