TOPIC: 2016-2017 Career and Technical Education Advisory Committee Scope of Work

BACKGROUND:

The Career and Technical Education Advisory Committee (CTEAC) is presenting the following items for consideration for its 2016-2017 scope of work.

1. Increase CTEAC membership to include representatives from additional program areas, specifically Automotive Technology and Health and Medical Sciences.
2. Continue to review and monitor CTE course offerings, and provide direction and advice for expanding, changing, and eliminating CTE courses, including new courses/programs for Patrick Henry PK-8 School.
3. Review CTE Annual Performance Report, Industry Certification test results, and student enrollment data to evaluate the effectiveness of CTE programs.
4. Continue increasing awareness of CTE programs by enhancing outreach and program publicity to stakeholders.
5. Approve a new Local Perkins plan for the 2017-2018 academic year.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Superintendent recommends that the School Board approve the CTE Scope of Work.

IMPACT: A focus by the CTE Advisory Committee on the above recommendations would provide greater opportunities for ACPS students to graduate ready for college and career.

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
