INTENSITY AS A LEARNER

- Becomes absorbed in area(s) of personal interest; explores topics beyond typical age level
- Learns quickly with little practice
- Has an exceptional amount of factual knowledge and applies it accurately
- Uses advanced vocabulary
- Demonstrates a determination to complete projects on time and at an advanced level

Examples from above of things my child said or did:

ANALYTICAL THINKER

- Demonstrates an interest in challenging situations – approaches problems from varied perspective; willingness to tackle difficult problems
- Demonstrates thinking that is complex and unusual for the age-level
- Skillfully takes apart and reassembles things or ideas
- Makes up metaphors or analogies
- Organizes collections of things uniquely; likes to plan or arrange things
- Presents arguments logically
- Enjoys planning and organizing

Examples from above of things my child said or did:

HIGHLY MOTIVATED

- Is independent
- Works cooperatively as a team member; is receptive to the ideas of others
- Strives to make meaning of situations
- Is an enthusiastic learner
- Is curious; experiments
- Assumes leadership positions; directs others
- Exhibits intense task commitment and energy when pursuing interests

Examples from above of things my child said or did:

CREATIVE PRODUCER

- Approaches problems from an unusual perspective
- Asks surprisingly intellectual and complex questions
- Initiates and completes elaborate, detailed projects
- Reads passages at an advanced, fluent reading level for age-level expectations
- Demonstrates a concern for injustice, social issues, and moral questions beyond age level
