Application for Free and Reduced Price Meals

An ACPS student may receive free and reduced price meals if his or her family income meets eligibility requirements. Parents who believe their children may be eligible for free or reduced price meals should complete an online or paper Application for Free and Reduced Price Meals. ***One application per household is needed each year to determine eligibility.***
