

VOTING METHOD

Each School Board Member's vote on every decision is recorded in the minutes of the meeting. The minutes of the meeting also reflect the method and result of all votes. No votes are taken by secret or written ballot.

In any case in which there is a tie vote of the School Board when all members are not present, the Clerk records the vote and the question is passed by until the next meeting, when it is again voted upon even though all members may not be present. A second tie vote defeats the motion, resolution or issue voted upon.
