TOPIC: 2015-2016 Career and Technical Education Advisory Committee Scope of Work

BACKGROUND:

The Career and Technical Education Advisory Committee (CTEAC) is presenting the following items for consideration for its 2015-2016 scope of work.

- 1. Increase CTEAC membership to include representatives from additional program areas, i.e., Automotive, Surgical Technology.
- 2. Continue to review and monitor CTE course offerings, and provide direction and advice for expanding, changing, and eliminating CTE courses.
- 3. Provide input and support for revisions of the CTE Strategic plan.
- 4. Review CTE Annual Performance Report, Industry Certification test results, and student enrollment data to evaluate the effectiveness of CTE programs.
- 5. Continue increasing awareness of CTE programs by enhancing outreach and program publicity to stakeholders.
- 6. Approve a new Local Perkins plan for the 2016-2017 academic year.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Superintendent recommends that the School Board approve the CTE Scope of Work.

IMPACT: A focus by the CTE Advisory Committee on the above recommendations would provide greater opportunities for ACPS students to graduate ready for college and career.

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
