**Answer:** The DSUP and Site plan amendment process is to be determined by the scope and design solutions proposed by the design team. Based on preliminary information, assuming there are no site or exterior changes, only a minor site plan amendment will be required. This includes:

- File for an administrative minor site plan amendment:
  - This amendment would be to SUP#96-106 which was a <u>Special Use</u> <u>Permit with Site Plan</u> that approved this office building along with the building at 1701 and the parking garage.
  - Update the site plan to reflect the new school use and any other changes to the building or site.
- Additional information that would need to accompany the amendment include, but not limited to:
  - Updated parking counts
  - Updated traffic study
  - A plan for bus drop-off / pick-up area
  - A plan for parent drop-off / pick-up
- A building permit could be filed upon approval of the amended site plan.
- Proposals should reflect an iterative process that ensures successful obtaining of the minor site plan approval and building permit. Please consider multiple submissions in your response.

If exterior changes to the building are required based on the needs of the school, or updates based on building code (expansion of stairwells, entrance relocation) this process may change. Per the RFP, we would like to see creative solutions for assembly/recreation space. However, on page 7 of the RFP under Tab 4 Appropriate Expertise, the RFP asks for a minimum of 3 projects completed within the past 5 years. Please confirm 1. The minimum # of projects required and whether or not the limit is the past 5 or 10 years.

**Answer:** Total of 5 minimum public K-5, K-8, or Middle School projects in the past 10 years. Of those, 3 must have been within the last 5 years.
